

2 ways to measure your ring size

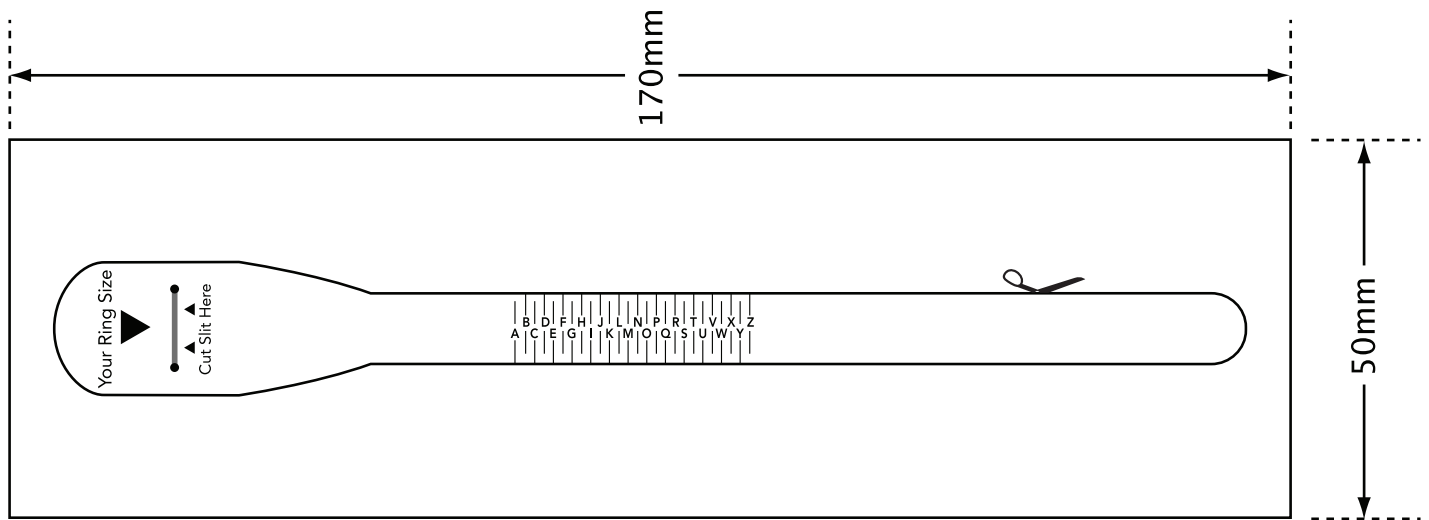
Print out this document at 100%. When printing ensure that you do not select the option to 'fit to page' or 'print to fit' or 'shrink to fit page'.

▶ Ring Sizer Belt:

1. Measure the outer box and ensure that it is 170mm by 50mm.
2. Cut out the sizer and make a slit where shown.
3. Push the end through the slit and slip it over your finger.
4. Adjust the sizer so that it sits comfortably around your finger.
5. Check that you can remove the sizer over your knuckle without difficulty.
6. Read off the letter indicated by the arrow and that is your size.


Please remember:

1. Ensure that the sizer can slide on and off your finger comfortably.
2. Do not pull on the sizer tightly as this will give you the wrong size.



▶ Ring Sizer Chart:

For the greatest accuracy, use a ring with a similar width band and style to the one you want to purchase

1. Check print size – the line right should measure 5cm. 
2. Place ring over the circles below.
3. Find the circle which completely fills the inside of the ring without overlapping.
4. Your ring size is the letter shown within the circle.

The ring sizers are provided as a guide only. For the greatest accuracy, please have your finger measured by a jeweller.
